

Parking—Remote Lot

The remote parking lot will be manned by the local GTA Fire Department. All vehicles parked in the lot must pay a \$3 parking fee. There will be parking attendants at the entrance of the lot to take payment and hand out a parking ticket that must be displayed on the dashboard inside the front window of each vehicle.

As a courtesy to the attendant and to be ensured a ticket, please have three \$1 bills ready.

REMOTE PARKING LOT (see map inside):

Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa

(Juncture of Mount Hope Rd. and Thunder Bay Rd.)

From the East

- Travel west on US Rt. 20.
- Turn right onto Eagle Ridge Dr.
(The Galena Territory entrance)
- Turn left onto Thunder Bay Rd.
- Follow signs to the lot.

From the West / Galena

- Travel east on US Rt. 20.
- Turn left onto Mt. Hope Rd.
- Follow signs to the lot.

RESIDENT DETOURS

Traffic re-routing will occur the morning of Saturday, May 22.

All traffic between Apple Canyon Lake and Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa will be delayed or detoured during the race. All intersections will be staffed by the Jo Daviess County Sheriff's Department.

Parking—Race Start

FRIDAY—Nixon Beach, Apple Canyon Lake

Parking will be available near the corner of S. Apple Canyon Rd. and Eisenhower Dr. DO NOT PARK ALONG THE SIDES of Eisenhower Dr. Shuttles will be available to transport you from the parking lot to Nixon Beach. Registration will be located at the Beach House at Nixon Beach.

SATURDAY—Nixon Beach, Apple Canyon Lake

There will be two parking areas at Nixon Beach on Race Day.

ACL Lot A:

If you plan to leave after the last triathletes have left Nixon Beach. Parking Lot A is located near the corner of S. Apple Canyon Rd. and Eisenhower Dr.

ACL Lot B:

If you plan to leave after the last duathlete is off the first run course and on the bike course. Parking Lot B is located near the corner of S. Apple Canyon Rd. and Pierce Ct.

SATURDAY—Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa

NO parking will be available at Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa. Park in the remote parking lot (*see Parking—Remote Lot section for information and fee*) and take a free shuttle to Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa Event Field.

Free Shuttle

Park in the remote parking lot (*see Parking—Remote Lot section for information and fee*) and take a free shuttle. Shuttles will transport athletes, spectators, and volunteers. Shuttles will run according to the schedule below. There is NO GUARANTEE OF SHUTTLE ARRIVAL OR DEPARTURE TIMES. Plan ahead and take the earliest shuttle possible. Shuttle buses will not leave at specific times; instead shuttles will leave as they are filled. Bikes and pets are NOT allowed on shuttles.

6 am – 7:30 am

Shuttles will run from the remote parking lot (*see map in center of brochure*) and Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa Event Field (Transition 2) to Apple Canyon Lake.

7:30 am – 3 pm

Shuttle will run between the remote parking lot and Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa Event Field.

Noon, 1 pm, 1:30 pm & 3 pm

Shuttle will run from Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa Event Field to Apple Canyon Lake (*one-way only*).

Shuttles will also be available to transport spectators from Apple Canyon Lake to Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa Event Field after the last athlete has left Nixon Beach and is on the bike route.



Way-Finder's Guide

Directions To Nixon Beach, Apple Canyon Lake

Site of registration, swim course and Duathlon run #1.

From Galena:

- From the intersection of N. Main St. & Meeker St., turn right onto Stagecoach Trail.
- Drive east for approximately 12 miles.
- Turn right onto Pea Ridge Rd.
- Pea Ridge Rd. will turn into W. Apple Canyon Rd.
- Turn left onto S. Apple Canyon Rd.
- Turn left onto Eisenhower Dr., Nixon Beach is at the end of Eisenhower Dr.

From Chicago:

- Take I-90 / 94 West to Rockford.
- Take US Rt. 20 West from Rockford to the Village of Woodbine.
- In Woodbine, turn right onto Scout Camp Rd.
- Turn left onto East Lake Rd., No. 3.
- Turn left onto S. Apple Canyon Rd.
- Turn right on Eisenhower Dr., Nixon Beach is at the end of Eisenhower Dr.

Directions To Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa

Bike course and site of finish line. **ROUTE WILL BE CLOSED DURING RACE.**

From Nixon Beach, Apple Canyon Lake:

- From Eisenhower Dr., turn right onto S. Apple Canyon Rd.
- Turn right onto W. Apple Canyon Rd.
- At the "Y" in the road stay to the left which will be Pea Ridge Rd.
- Stay on Pea Ridge Rd. until it intersects with Stagecoach Trail.
- Turn left onto Stagecoach Trail.
- Turn left onto Elizabeth / Scales Mound Rd.
- Turn right onto W. Rawlins Rd. Stay to the left onto N. Morley Rd.
- Turn right on W. Wachter Rd. for 2.5 miles.
- Turn left on Territory Dr.
- Turn right on Eagle Ridge Dr. to Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa. (*Site of finish line.*)

Directions To Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa

Spectator Route to be used during the Saturday event.

From Nixon Beach, Apple Canyon Lake:

- From Eisenhower Dr. turn left onto S. Apple Canyon Rd.
- S. Apple Canyon Rd. will turn into E. Apple Canyon Rd.
- Turn right onto E. Lake Rd., No. 3.
- Turn right onto Scout Camp Rd.
- At the Village of Woodbine, turn right onto US Rt. 20 and travel west.
- Park in the remote parking lot (see *Parking—Remote Lot* section for information and fee) and take a free shuttle (see *Shuttle* section) to Eagle Ridge Resort & Spa. (Site of finish line.)
